



Getting from the airport to Magdeburg

We recommend coming via the airports Berlin, Hannover, Leipzig, as these have the most convenient connections to Magdeburg.

Berlin – Magdeburg

Airport Berlin Tegel:

At the airport Berlin-Tegel take bus TXL or bus X9 to station „Berlin Hauptbahnhof“. Then take a train towards Magdeburg. Alternative: Take the suburban line S25 via “Teltow Stadt” until “Berlin Friedrich Straße” and change there into a train towards Magdeburg.

Duration: about 2-3 hours

Costs: about € 20-35

Airport Berlin Schönefeld:

There is a train station with connections to Magdeburg right at the airport.

Duration: about 2-2,5 hours

Costs: about € 20-30

Hannover – Magdeburg

At the airport Hannover take the tram no. 5 (destination “Bad Pyrmont” or “Hameln”). Get off at the main station “Hannover Hauptbahnhof” and take a train to Magdeburg.

Duration: about 1,5-2 hours

Costs: about € 20-35

Leipzig/Halle – Magdeburg

There is a train station with direct connections to Magdeburg right at the airport.

Duration: about 1 hour

Costs: about € 20-25

Another transport option is provided by various **long-distance coach companies**. Several service providers and prices can be compared on the online portal www.busliniensuche.de. The largest coach company in Germany is **Flixbus**. www.flixbus.de. The departure points from Berlin to Magdeburg are Berlin Central Bus Station (ZOB) by the Funkturm (broadcasting tower) or Berlin Alexanderplatz. From Magdeburg you can take the train to Stendal.

Google Playstore/Apple Appstore also have the **apps** for Deutsche Bahn, BlaBlaCar and Flixbus for information on the go about departure times and booking.
