Subject to the allocation and availability of funding, Magdeburg-Stendal University of Applied Sciences is seeking to fill, at the earliest opportunity, the following post in the Department of Water, Environment, Construction and Safety, for its "Water Management and Climate Change in the Focus of International Master Programmes / WATERMAS" project, which is supported by the ERASMUS+ programme of the European Union:

The post, which is for 20 hours per week, is currently limited until Oct., 14th, 2019, and can be extended, depending on the confirmation of the sponsoring body up to 2 years at a whole in accordance with the German Law Time Work and Temporary Employment Contracts (TzBfG). The post falls into category 9 TV-salary scale.

Areas of responsibility

The applicant will provide project management and will support the project coordination with regard to administrative and professional steering and coordination tasks for the ERASMUS+ project, technical aspects of the work and preparation of legworks for individual contributions of the project coordinator. The role also includes a close cooperation with the Latin American manager and project team members, organising workshops, and student and scientist exchanges and make the overall project management. The post holder will also take part in trips abroad of up to several weeks' duration.

Conditions of employment

Applications are sought from candidates holding either a good or excellent university degree, preferably in the fields of hydrology, water management, civil engineering or comparable courses (Bachelor's or Master's degree or university diploma). Particular expertise and interest in the areas of water conservation and climate change are desirable. The candidate must have command of English and Spanish, whilst German language skills are also mandatory. Expertise is also required in the fields of water management and conservation, hydrology, hydrochemistry and hydrobiology, as well as numerical modelling. Applicants should be motivated and have the ability to work independently. They should have competencies in team work, communication and should have self-confident as well as polite and courteous character.
