12:45 – 14:15	<p>Bus ride on the Kalimandscharo</p> <p>The snow-white mountain of salt spoil at K+S KALI GmbH's Zielitz plant has the highest altitude between Magdeburg and the Baltic Sea. Known as the Kalimandscharo, this elevation provides an imposing view of huge forests and of Europe's largest waterway junction.</p>

Late Summer School 2017

15:00 – 16:30 Magdeburg waterway junction

Gigantic lift and lock constructions together with the world's largest trough bridge form the Magdeburg waterway junction. The trough bridge connects the Mittelland (Midland) Canal to the Elbe. The tour will start with a visit to the waterways development agency's information centre where a model will be used to explain how the structure works. We will then go to the ship lift and the water-saving lock, which are located in the Rothensee area of Magdeburg.

Approx. 17:30 Arrive back at the university car park by bus

The cost per participant is 30 euros, including lunch and a soft drink.

Meet at Haus NaturSinn (Nature & Senses House; Herrenkrugstrasse 141, D-39114 Magdeburg)
Haus NaturSinn – creativity with and in nature

On this day participants get to know themselves and the group in new situations and develop or deepen their sense of community through joint tasks and challenges with plenty of fun and pizzazz. Group cohesion, trust, and the ability to recognise and deal constructively with one's own strengths and weaknesses all develop from positive experiences that remain in the memory and can be utilised much later in a variety of everyday situations. The content of the course is tailored individually to the needs of the group through an initial discussion with an experienced experiential educator.

During the guided tour of Haus NaturSinn, the participants are taught methods of active sensory and natural perception. They get to know themselves and the group in new situations and develop or deepen their sense of community through joint tasks and challenges with plenty of fun and pizzazz. After an introduction to the "Concept and Philosophy" of the establishment, the participants are familiarised with culinary and medicinal herbs and then get to make natural bodycare products with them. Playfully they attempt to activate their senses and experience being in a new and conscious manner. Participants can enjoy a lunchtime snack on site before concluding their visit by producing plant dyes for use in creative crafts.

11:30 – 14:30	Tour of the MDR radio broadcasting centre in Halle Halle is the radio city of MDR (Mitteldeutscher Rundfunk, the Central German Broadcasting Corporation). Since 1999 the broadcaster has transmitted four supra-regional radio stations (MDR JUMP, MDR INFO, MDR FIGARO and MDR SPUTNIK) from the city on the River Saale. MDR KLASSIK, a digital radio station, was launched here in 2002. This building also has a studio for LANDESFUNKHAUS SACHSEN-ANHALT, which provides regional programming for Saxony-Anhalt. MDR's radio tour is for everyone who wants to find out more about their favourite radio station or host, but will also provide our students with insights into the industry.
14:45 – 16:00	Walk as a group to Halle's main train station (Hauptbahnhof) and enjoy free time to explore the shops, etc. there; return journey to Magdeburg at 16:14 (RE 16326)
Approx. 17:30	Arrive back in Magdeburg
